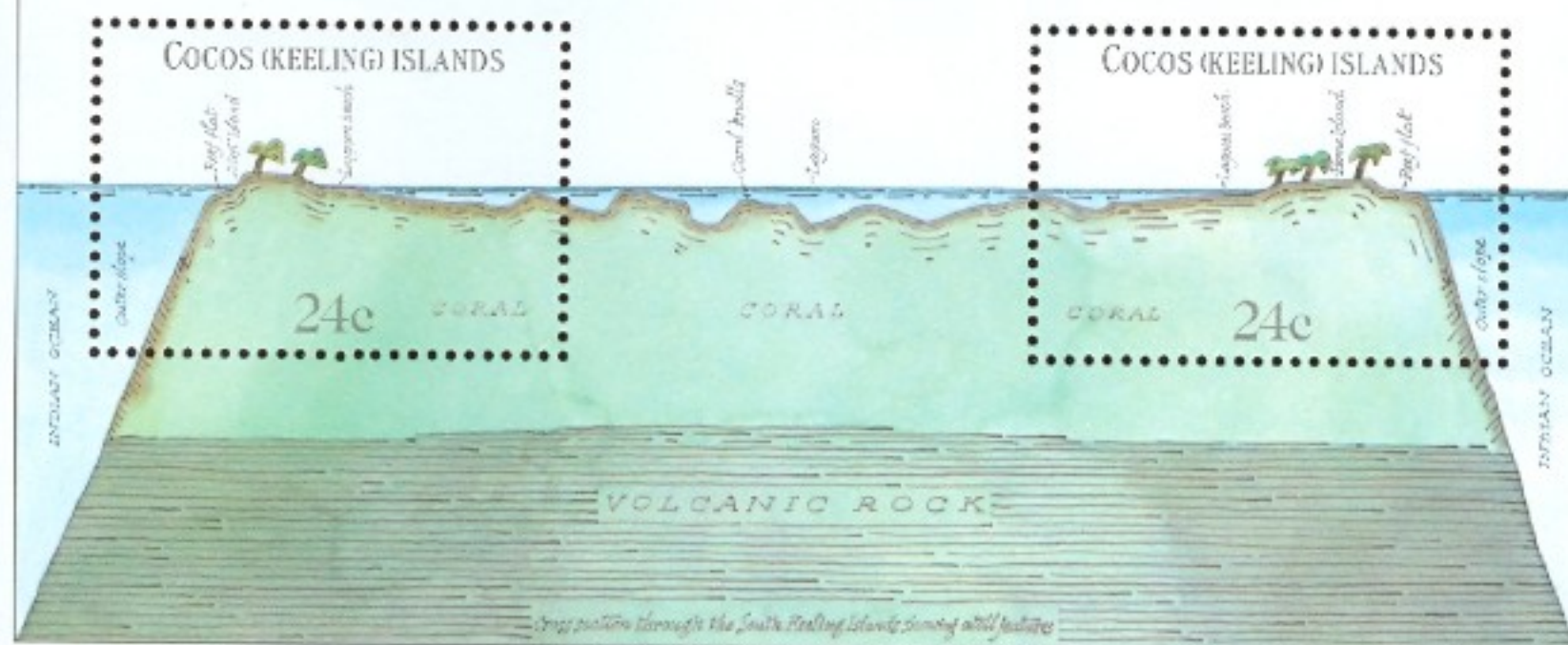


THEORY OF SUBSIDENCE OF ATOLLS AND CORAL REEFS

ON LEAVING THE COCOS ISLANDS ON 12TH APRIL 1836 CHARLES DARWIN WROTE: "I am glad we had visited these islands, such formations surely rank high amongst the wonderful objects of this world. We feel surprise when travellers tell us of the vast dimensions of the Pyramids and other great ruins, but how utterly insignificant are the greatest of these when compared to these mountains of stone accumulated by the agency of various minute and tender animals!"

This is a wonder which does not at first strike the eye of the body, but after reflection, the eye of reason."

125th Anniversary of Pitcairn Migration to Norfolk Island



ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATED WITH ANNIVERSARY DAY ON NORFOLK ISLAND TO COMMEMORATE THE SAFE ARRIVAL OF THE PITCAIRNERS

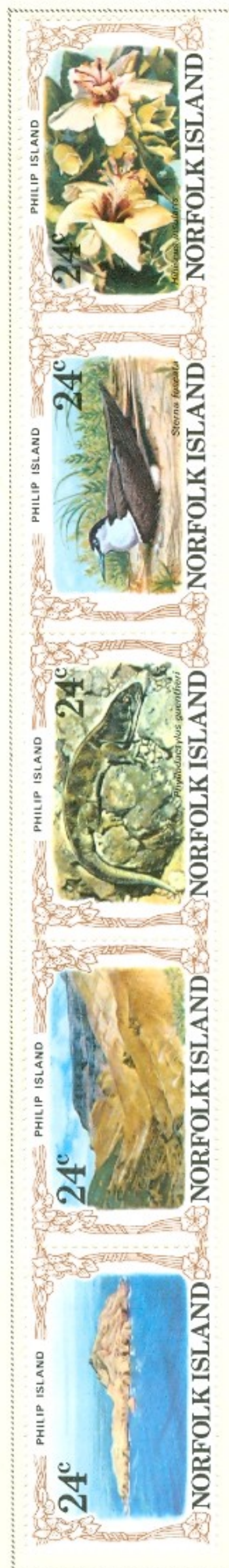
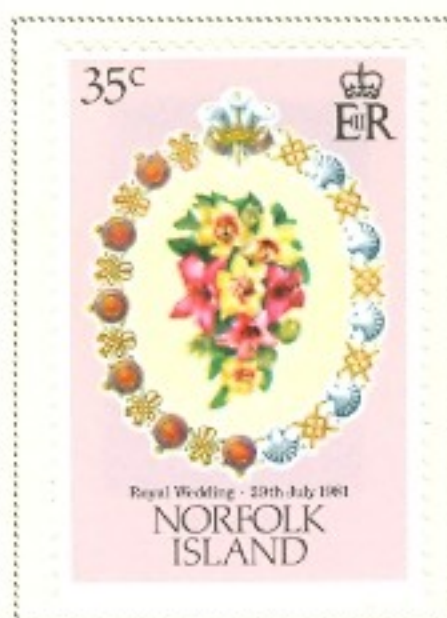
On the 8th June 1856, the Pitcairners landed on Norfolk Island, and each year since that date the descendants of the Pitcairn families have commemorated the safe arrival in traditional fashion. The 8th June each year is set aside as a public holiday. The day's festivities commence with a re-enactment of the original landing. A procession from the pier to the cenotaph and the graveyard for the laying of wreaths and the singing of hymns follows. The families of the Pitcairn descendants then proceed to Government House for the judging of the most original dressed family. The singing of grace precedes the commencement of the Anniversary Day Picnic. After the Picnic Lunch the Annual Cricket match between 'The Bounty' team and the 'Allcomers' team is contested. The festivities conclude at night with the Bounty Ball.

NORFOLK ISLAND 200th ANNIVERSARY OF MANNED FLIGHT



45c – French DC4
The 45c stamp illustrates a French DC4 military aircraft which used to visit Norfolk Island from Noumea. Confirmed reports reveal that the aircraft was presented to General De Gaulle by General Eisenhower sometime after World War II. The aircraft crashed in Noumea in 1951 tragically killing eight military personnel.

75c – Sikorsky Helicopter
The Sikorsky helicopter on the 75c stamp visited Norfolk Island for fuel during a flight from New Zealand to Sydney. This was the first American helicopter to visit the island on a long range flight.



10c – Beechcraft
The Beechcraft shown on the 10c stamp conducted a number of aerial resupply programmes of Norfolk Island and the surrounding two islands. The aircraft is now housed in a museum in New Zealand.

27c – Fokker F28 Fellowship
Since 30th April 1983 the Fokker Fellowship 128-4000 has been flying the Green and Gold colours of East West Airlines on the 1651 kilometre journey from Sydney to Norfolk. Assisted by its fuel efficient and quiet Rolls Royce engine the journey time has been reduced from 4hrs 40 mins to 2hrs 50 mins.
