## BOTSWANA

FIRST NATIONAL CURRENCY ISSUE



The first national currency of Botswana will be introduced later in 1976. The basic unit will be the PULA, meaning rain, and will be divided into one hundred sub-units, called THEBE, meaning shields.

The four new banknotes, in addition to their monetary function, also serve as a picture gallery of Botswana and are considered to be among the most attractive currency designs in the world.

The front of each note features a striking portrait of the President and Founder of modern Botswana, Sir Seretse Khama, as indicated on the 10 Pula note which displays on the back, a view of the National Assembly; the other notes display selected typical Botswana scenes, with inscriptions in Setswana.

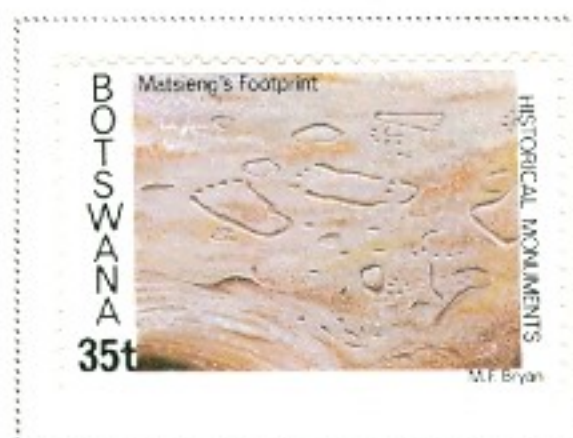
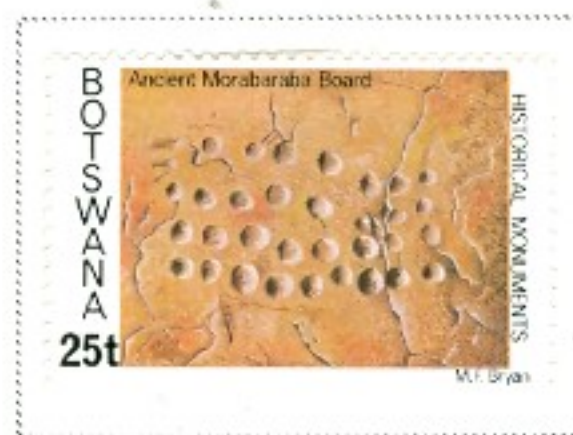
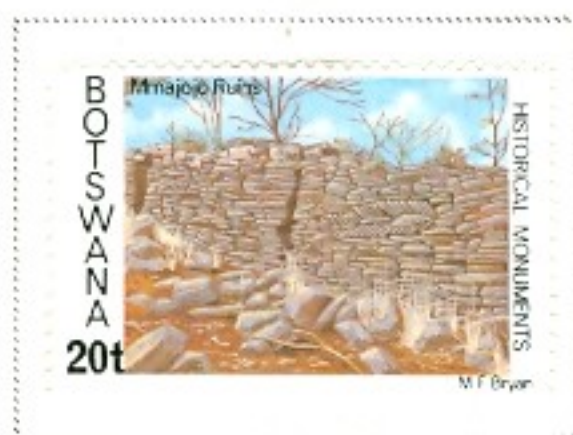
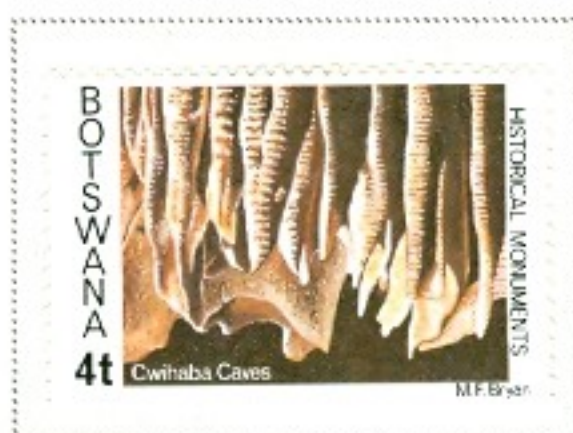
