Human Rights Declaration



Whereas recognition of the inherent dignity and of the equal and inalienable rights of all members of the human family is the foundation of freedom, justice and peace in the world,

Whereas disregard and contempt for human rights have resulted in barbarous acts which have outraged the conscience of mankind, and the advent of a world in which human beings shall enjoy freedom of speech and belief and freedom from fear and want has been proclaimed as the highest aspiration of the common people,

Whereas it is essential, if man is not to be compelled to have recourse, as a last resort, to rebellion against tyranny and oppression, that human rights should be protected by the rule of law, Whereas it is essential to promote the development of friendly relations between nations, Whereas the peoples of the United Nations have in the Charter reaffirmed their faith in fundamental human rights, in the dignity and worth of the human person and in the equal rights of men and women and have

determined to promote social progress and better standards of life in larger freedom, Whereas Member States have pledged themselves to achieve, in co-operation with the United Nations, the promotion of universal respect for and



observance of human rights and fundamental freedoms, Whereas a common understanding of these rights and freedoms is of the greatest importance for the full realization of this pledge, now, therefore, the General Assembly proclaims This Universal Declaration of Human Rights as a common standard of achievement for all peoples and all nations, to the end that every individual and every organ of society, keeping this Declaration constantly in mind, shall strive by teaching and education to promote respect for these rights and freedoms and by progressive measures, national and international, to secure their universal and effective recognition and observance, both among the peoples of Member States themselves and among the peoples of territories under their jurisdiction.

Human Rights Declaration

Da die Anerkennung der allen Mitgliedern der menschlichen Familie innewohnenden Würde und ihrer gleichen und unveräußerlichen Rechte die Grundlage der Freiheit, der Gerechtigkeit und des Friedens in der Welt bildet,

da Verkenning und Mißachtung der Menschenrechte zu Akten der Barbarei führten, die das Gewissen der Menschheit tief verletzt haben, und da die Schaffung einer Welt, in der den Menschen, frei von Furcht und Not, Rede- und Glaubensfreiheit zuteil wird, als das höchste Bestreben der Menschheit verkündet worden ist, da es wesentlich ist, die Menschenrechte durch die Herrschaft des Rechtes zu schützen, damit der Mensch nicht zum Aufstand gegen Tyrannei und Unterdrückung als letztem Mittel gezwungen wird, da es wesentlich ist, die Entwicklung freundschaftlicher Beziehungen zwischen den Nationen zu fördern, da die Völker der Vereinten Nationen in der Satzung ihren Glauben an die grundlegenden Menschenrechte, an die Würde und den Wert der menschlichen Person und an die Gleichberechtigung von Mann und

Frau erneut bekräftigt und beschlossen haben, den sozialen Fortschritt und bessere Lebensbedingungen bei größerer Freiheit zu fördern, da die Mitgliedstaaten sich verpflichtet haben, in Zusammenarbeit mit den Vereinten Nationen



die allgemeine Achtung und Verwirklichung der Menschenrechte und Grundfreiheiten durchzusetzen, da eine gemeinsame Auffassung über diese Rechte und Freiheiten von größter Wichtigkeit für die volle Erfüllung dieser Verpflichtung ist, proklamiert die Generalversammlung diese Allgemeine Erklärung der Menschenrechte als das von allen Völkern und Nationen zu erreichende gemeinsame Ideal, damit jeder einzelne und alle Organe der Gesellschaft sich diese Erklärung stets gegenwärtig halten und sich bemühen, durch Unterricht und Erziehung die Achtung dieser Rechte und Freiheiten zu fördern und durch fortschreitende Maßnahmen im nationalen und internationalen Bereiche ihre allgemeine und tatsächliche Anerkennung und Verwirklichung bei der Bevölkerung sowohl der Mitgliedstaaten wie der ihrer Oberhoheit unterstehenden Gebiete zu gewährleisten.







Human Rights Declaration

Considérant que la reconnaissance de la dignité inhérente à tous les membres de la famille humaine et de leurs droits égaux et inaliénables constitue le fondement de la liberté, de la justice et de la paix dans le monde,  Considérant que la méconnaissance et le mépris des droits de l'homme ont conduit à des actes de barbarie qui révoltent la conscience de l'humanité et que l'avènement d'un monde où les êtres humains seront libres de parler et de croire, libérés de la terreur et de la misère, a été proclamé comme la plus haute aspiration de l'homme,  Considérant qu'il est essentiel que les droits de l'homme soient protégés par un régime de droit pour que l'homme ne soit pas contraint, en suprême recours, à la révolte contre la tyrannie et l'oppression,  Considérant qu'il est essentiel d'encourager le développement de relations amicales entre nations,  Considérant que dans la Charte les peuples des Nations Unies ont proclamé à nouveau leur foi dans les droits fondamentaux de l'homme, dans la dignité et la valeur de la personne humaine, dans l'égalité des droits



des hommes et des femmes, et qu'ils se sont déclarés résolus à favoriser le progrès social et à instaurer de meilleures conditions de vie dans une liberté plus grande,  Considérant que les Etats Membres se sont engagés à assurer, en coopération avec l'Organisation des Nations Unies, le respect universel et effectif des droits de l'homme et des libertés fondamentales,  Considérant qu'une conception commune de ces droits et libertés est de la plus haute importance pour remplir pleinement cet engagement, l'Assemblée générale proclame la présente Déclaration universelle des droits de l'homme comme l'idéal commun à atteindre par tous les peuples et toutes les nations afin que tous les individus et tous les organes de la société, ayant cette Déclaration constamment à l'esprit, s'efforcent, par l'enseignement et l'éducation, de développer le respect de ces droits et libertés et d'en assurer, par des mesures progressives d'ordre national et international, la reconnaissance et l'application universelles et effectives, tant parmi les populations des Etats Membres eux-mêmes que parmi celles des territoires placés sous leur juridiction.

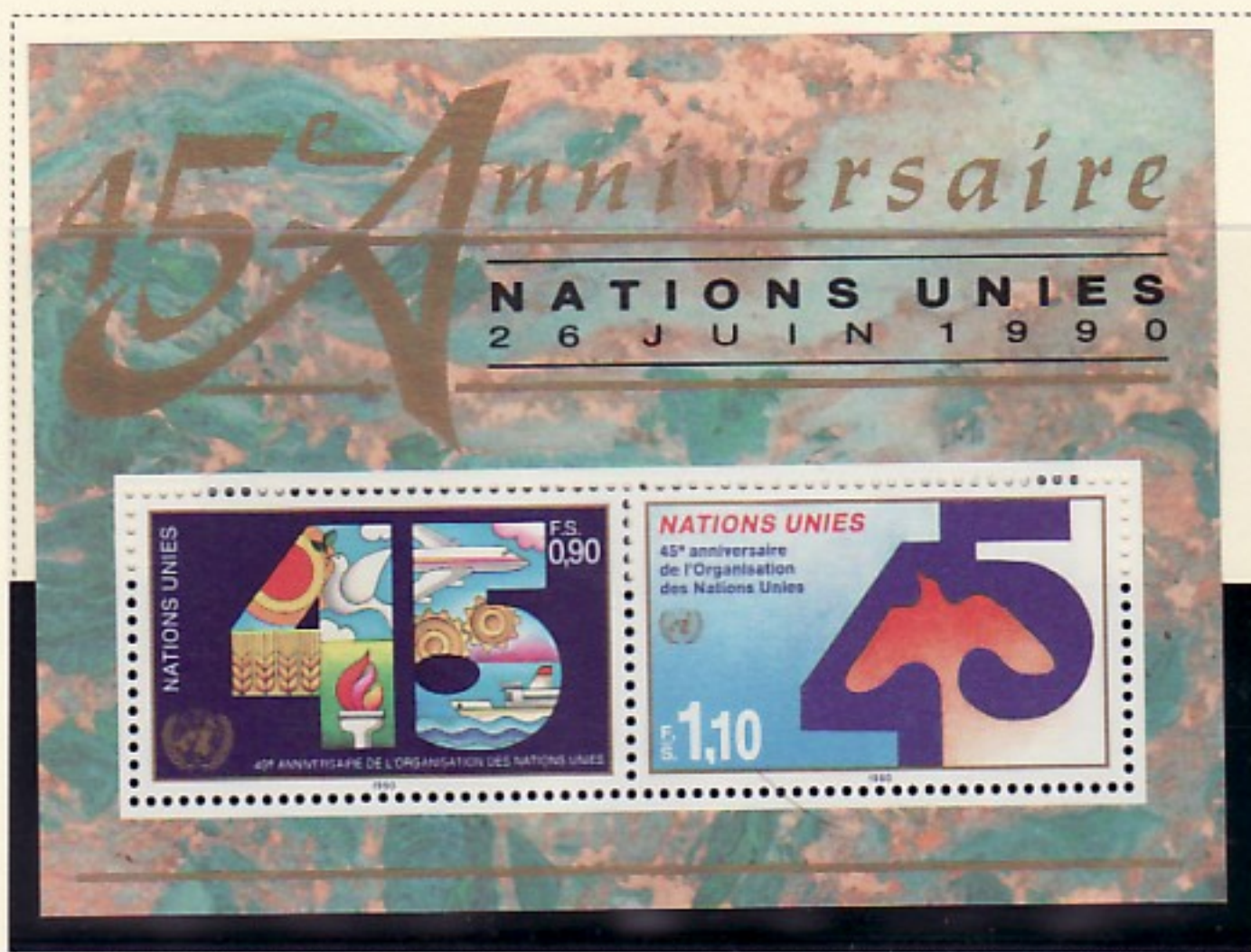
