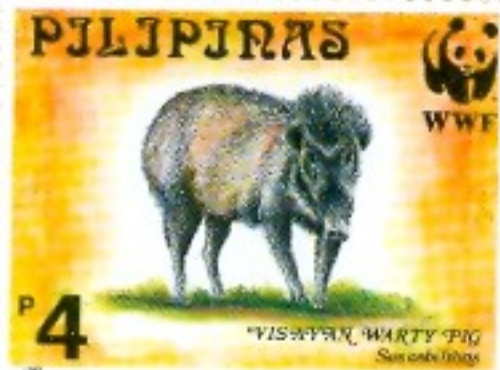


**Visayan Spotted Deer**

Coat coloration is very variable: the color ranges from dark chocolate brown to fox red; some animals have very distinct yellowish or white spots, others less so; some have white throat patches, some do not. Only the males sport antlers.

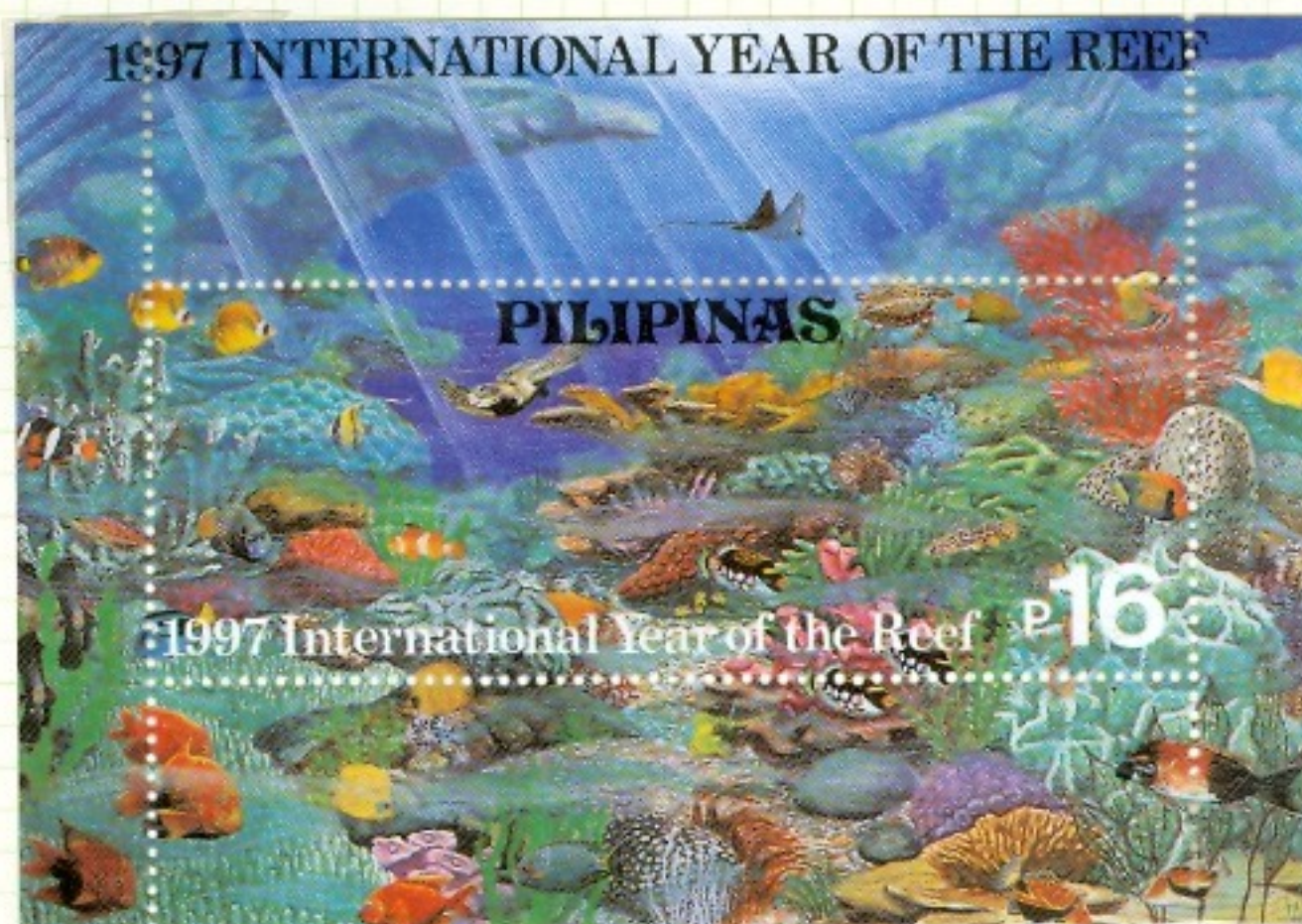

Visayan Warty Pig (*Sus cebifrons*)

The Visayan Warty Pig *Sus cebifrons* is found only on the islands of Panay and Negros in the Philippines. Distinct regional differences are apparent between the adult males; Negros boars are usually darker in color with a more distinct white snout band, while Panay boars have much lighter coats and less distinct facial markings.

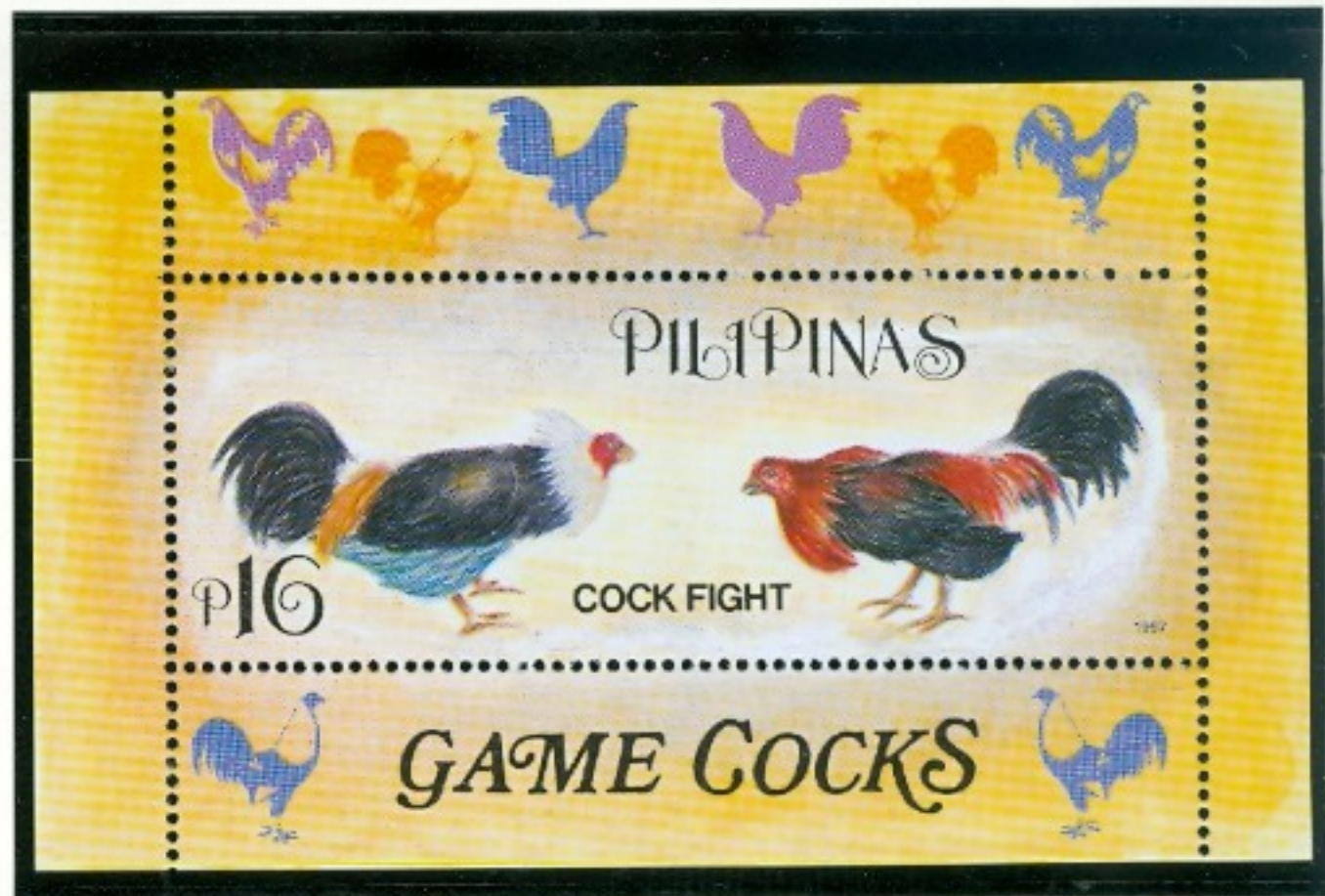


**Visayan Warty Pig (*Sus cebifrons*)**

The Visayan Warty Pig *Sus cebifrons* is a critically endangered species. It has been extirpated from at least 95 percent of its former range in the West Visayas, with probably no more than a few dozen individuals surviving in the wild. Habitat protection is now being extended, and a captive breeding programme has been initiated.



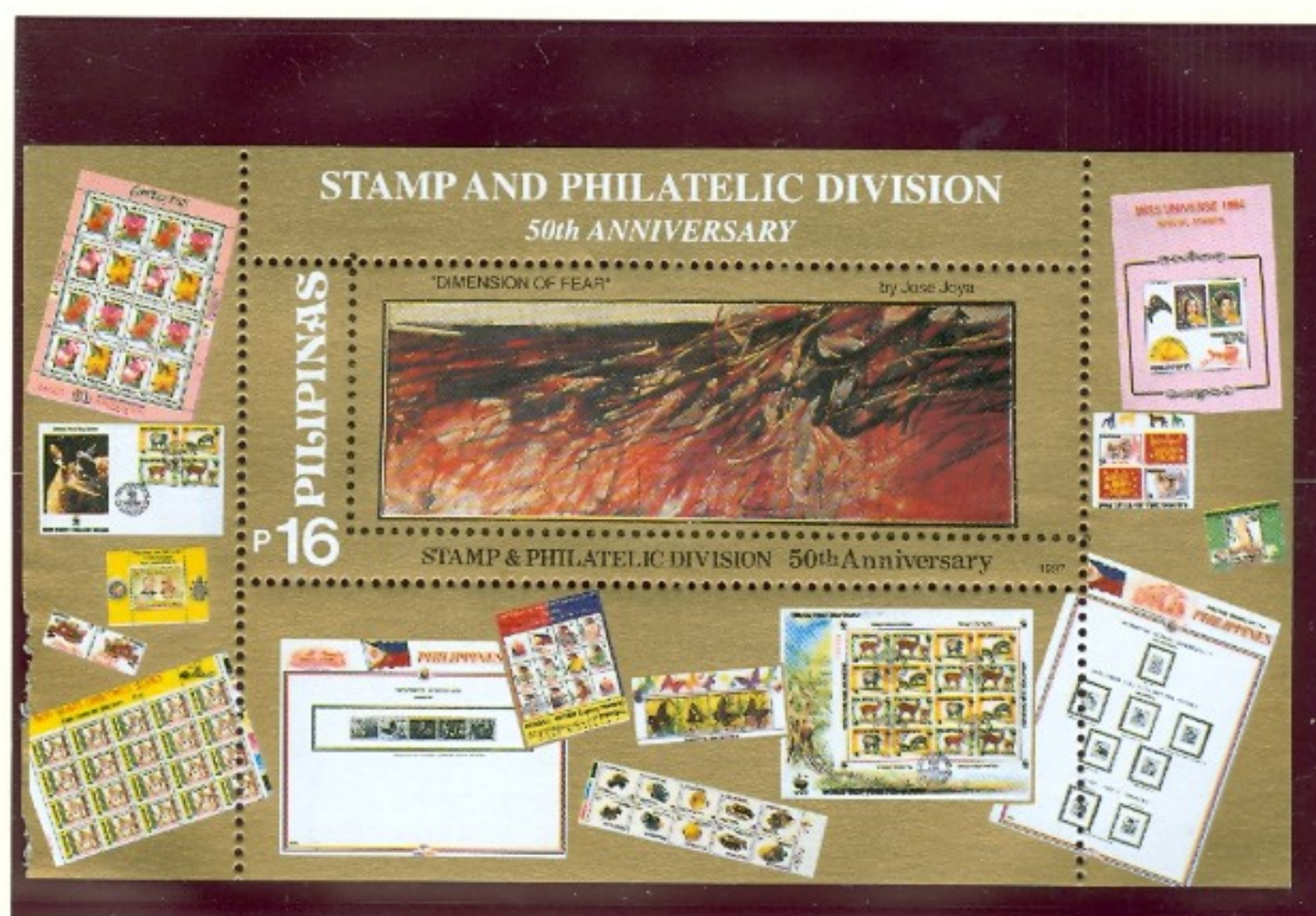

**Bio-diversity.** Ours is a land overflowing with nature's bounty: a virtual kaleidoscope of flora and fauna. Around 10,000 species of ferns and flowering plants embrace our soils. An estimated 740 species of birds (including the majestic monkey-eating eagle) roam our skies and 700 varieties of butterflies add color to our landscape. ### PRIDE IN HERITAGE

**The Migration of the Malays to Philippine Shores.** From 300 B.C. up to the 15th century A.D., the orient seas experienced waves of Malay migration. Brightly-garbed and brown-skinned, their race boasted of skilled and cunning sailors. They travelled rough seas in communities; utilizing great sailboats known as "balanghays." This would evolve into the "barangay", which became the Filipino term for a community. Among the Malays' contributions were tools and weapons, an alphabet and arts like weaving and pottery. Their introduction of the horse and the carabao in field work proved handy in turning what was a wild and uncultivated land into productive greenery.

#### The Liberation of the People.

On July 7, 1892, a secret society known as the Katipunan was born. Its founder was Andres Bonifacio. Its mission: to unite all Filipinos and help liberate a country long exploited by foreign rule. One of the Katipunan's celebrated members was a patriot named Emilio Aguinaldo. On June 12, 1898, General Emilio Aguinaldo proclaimed the independence of the Philippines with historic ceremonies in Kawit, Cavite.

### PRIDE IN LITERATURE

**The Living Scripts.** Grunts and gestures were man's first means of communicating with his fellowmen. As soon as he started developing a semblance of spoken language, he began to yearn for permanence in his interaction with others. Hence, the birth of the written form. The early Filipinos shared this similar desire for permanence in their dealings. There are four (4) scripts in the Philippines. They are the scripts of the Tagalogs, Hanunuos and Buhids of Mindoro and the Tagbanwas of Palawan. Although the Tagalog script quickly faded from the Philippine scene after the Spaniards arrived, the other three survived. Usually in the form of poems, these early writing systems utilized contemporary imagery. In these scripts our ancestors told stories rich with imagination.

## PHILIPPINE OWLS

The **Negros Scops-owl** (*Otus megalotis nigrorum*) is generally considered a subspecies of the Philippine Scops-owl *Otus megalotis* but might in fact be a full species, *Otus nigrorum*. It is a small owl, with a length of around 20 cm., and has orange-red eyes and a rufous fascial disk. It is known only from lowland forests on Negros and Panay. Since its habitat has almost entirely disappeared, it is one of the most threatened of all Philippine owls and therefore classified as Critically Endangered.
